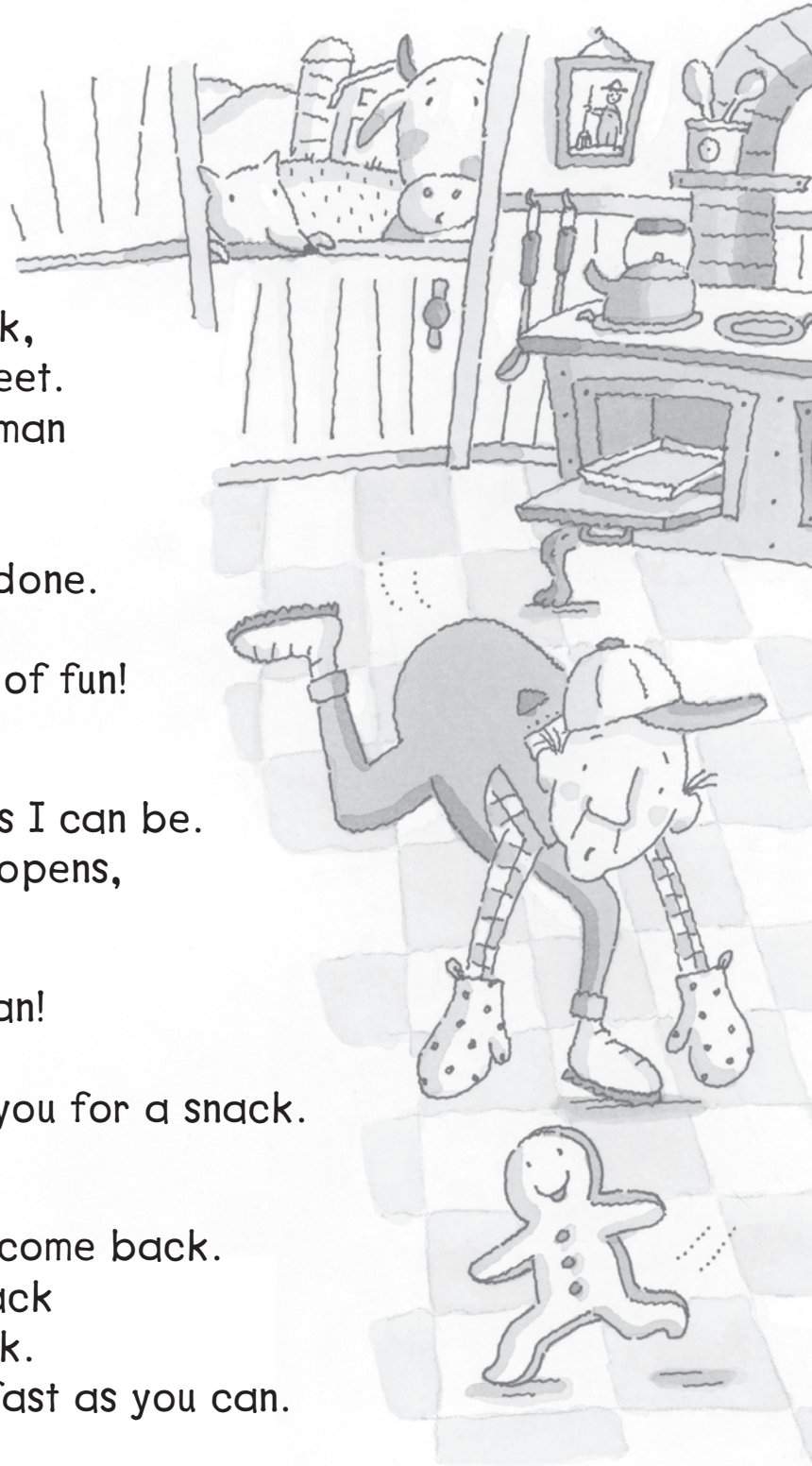
Farmer	Cow
